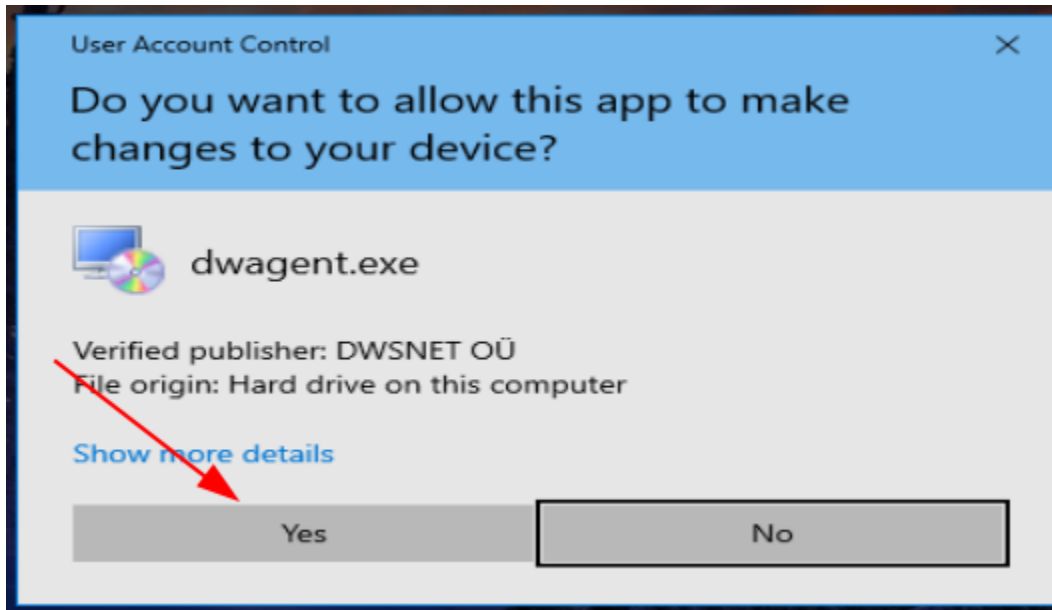
Right click on the download located at the bottom of your browser window, and click "open"



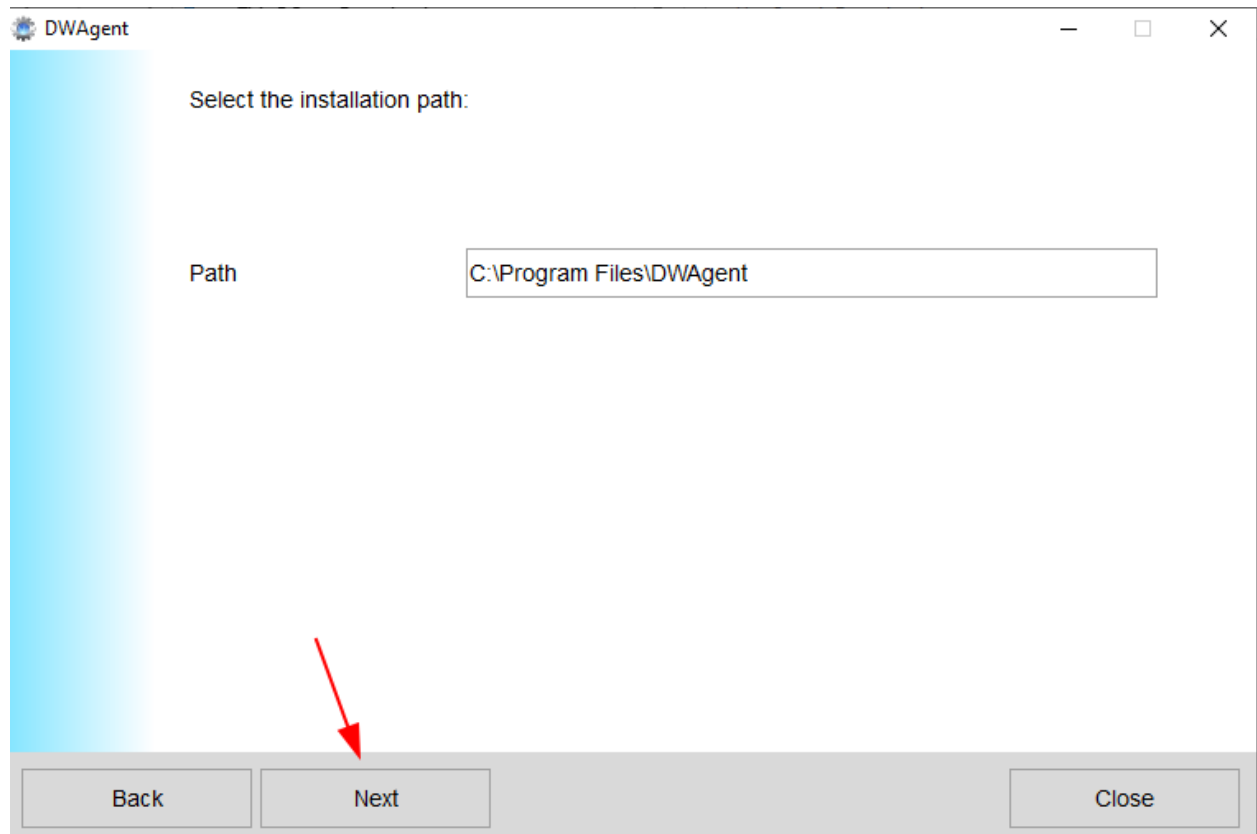
Click "Install" then click Next



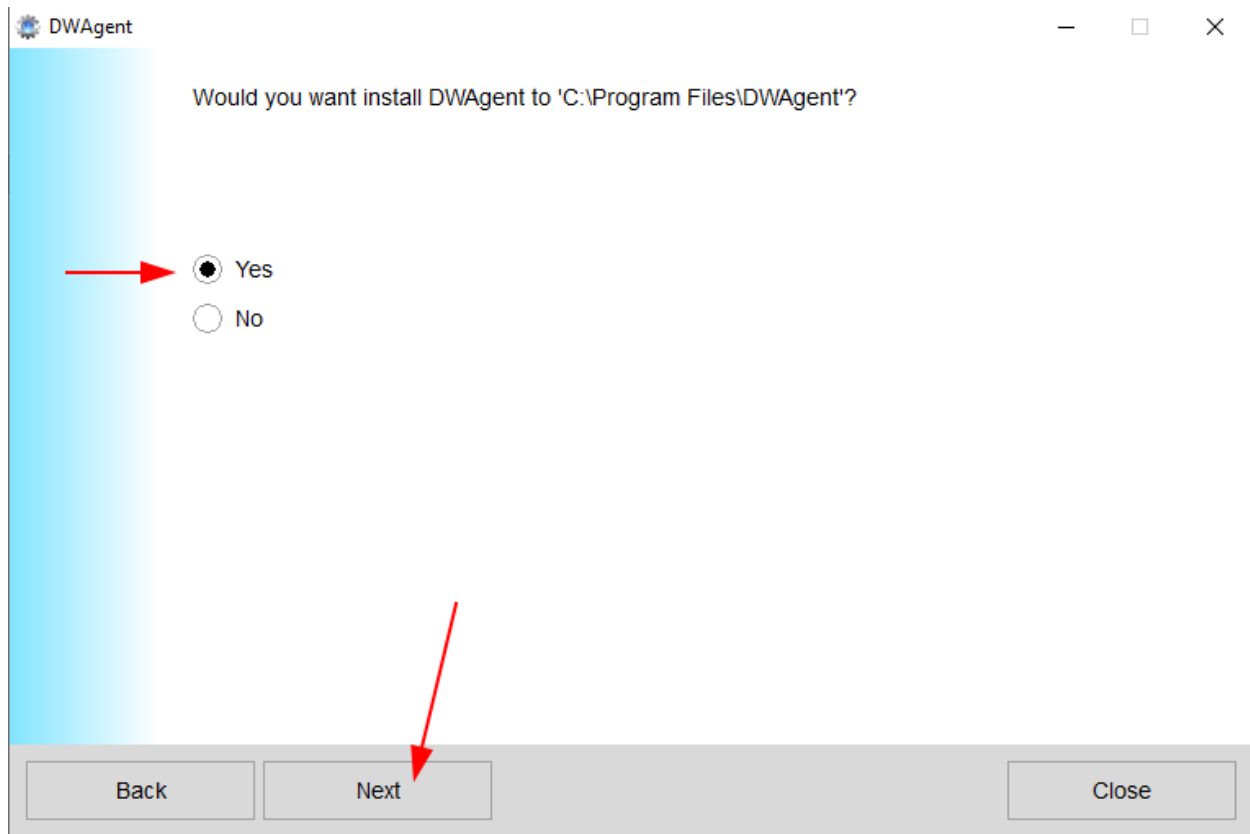
Security pop says do you want to allow this app to make changes to this device, click "Yes".



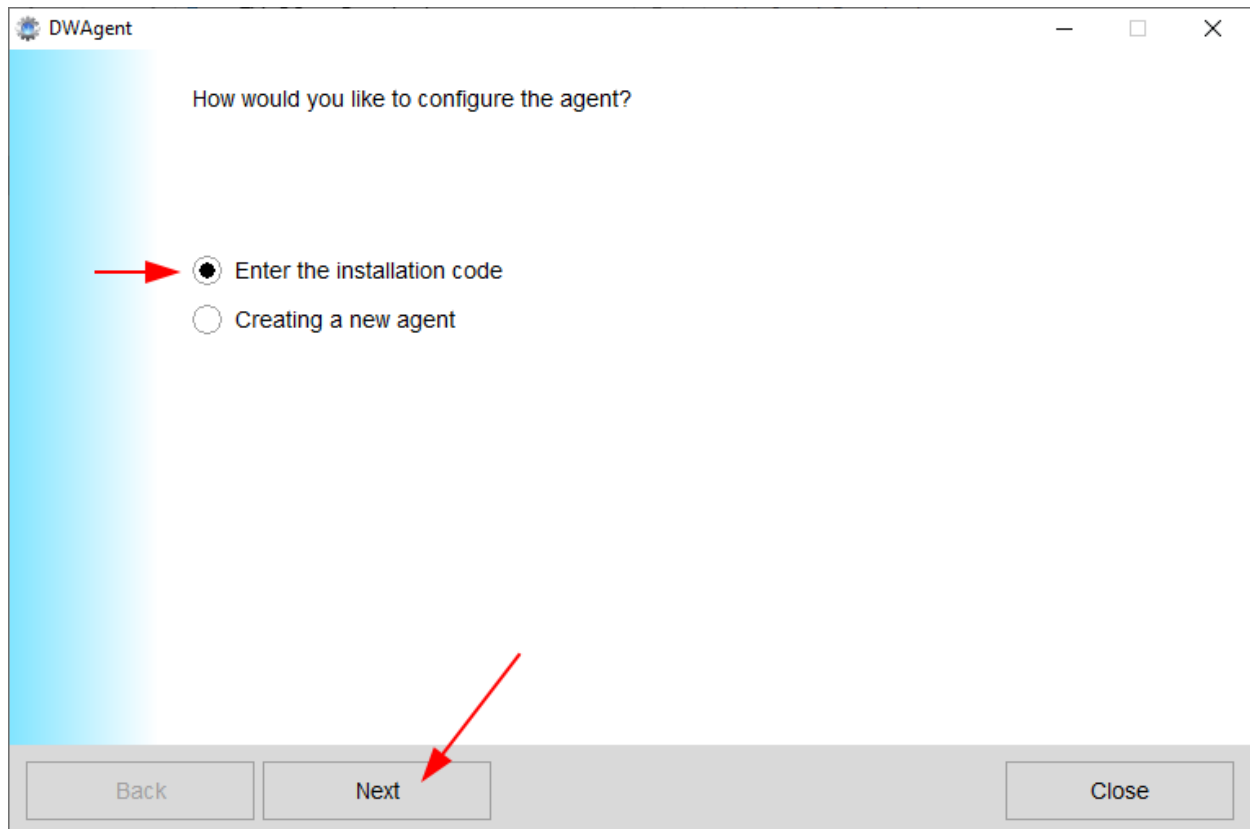
The path can be changed if you want, but the default is fine, click "Next".

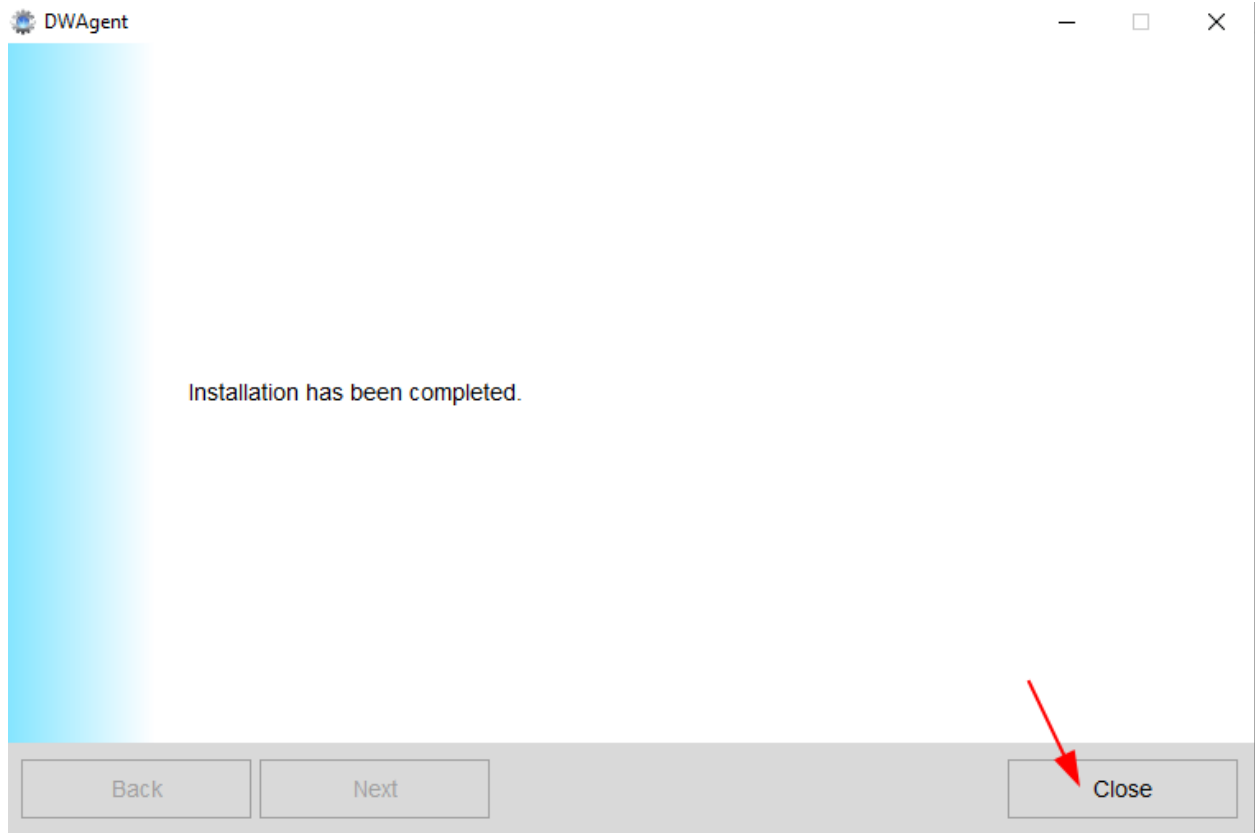
